He went over the 24 difference between a CDD and an HOA for the audience; he explained what a CDD is and how it 25 operates. Supervisor Lefere also went over some of the statutes, how elections work, what the CDD 26 maintains, why CDDs are created, bonds, operations and maintenance, and assessments. 27 The entire discussion is available on audio. 28 29 30 31 2. PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS 32 33 Residents asked about CDD assets, paying off the bond, the benefits of having a CDD, if the CDD 34 is private or public, the landscaping near the mailboxes, the fences, how the size of a community 35 affects a CDD, future building plans, and retention ponds overflowing after the hurricane. There 36 were many resident comments about drainage issues. 37 38 Supervisor Lefere, Ms. Chamberlain, and Mr. Roberts answered their questions. Supervisor Lefere 39 said the District Engineer will be sent out to assess the drainage issues. 40 41 The entire discussion is available on audio. 42 43 Supervisor Lefere also said that two residents will be elected to the Board in 2020 and the Fiscal 44 Year for the CDD begins in October. Ms. Chamberlain said the budget meetings will be in May and 45 August, and they have already been scheduled. Notices will only be sent if assessments increase.
